Program Information

Our full-day pre-school program starts at age three. Each of our programs offers a well-rounded curriculum with a focus on the following areas of a child's growth: cognitive, fine arts, social, emotional, and physical. The teachers at Merriday School understand that children learn at their own pace, that they need to be actively engaged to learn, and that play is an integral part of the learning process.

Small groups allow teachers to be aware of the needs of each child and to offer individualized attention when necessary, while children have a better chance to cooperate among themselves.

Children in all programs receive specialized instruction in Spanish, art, and music movement.

Merriday School encourages each child to develop socially, as an individual, responding to personal needs while adapting to the challenges of learning skills.

Hours are 7:00 am—5:30 pm.

Merriday School Curriculum

We offer an academic based curriculum that incorporates guided activities with learning centers to introduce themes and concepts to our students.

We provide guidance through the early stages of self and social awareness.

With both freedom to explore, and careful supervision, activities are geared to the growing needs and potentials of each child.

Imagination and creativity are encouraged through the use of puzzles, books, manipulatives, playtime, music, dance, singing, games, and stories.

Merriday Summer School

The Merriday Summer School program is for ages 3-10 years old. Our pre-school and pre-kindergarten children are immersed in age appropriate activities including swimming lessons, free swim, dance, drama, art, gardening, music, and play.

Our school age children, grades K-4 also receive swim lessons by certified swim instructors and participate in a variety of activities including free swim, outdoor play, sports, card and board games, and themed celebrations (luau, fiesta, etc.). The children have competed in a mini olympics, created a carnival for the younger children, and prepared special lunches.

Summer School children bring their own lunch, bathing suit, and towel(s). Snacks are provided.

Summer School hours are 7:00 am—5:30 pm, Monday thru Friday.
